CAPE MAY POINT TROLLEY TOUR

(also available as a Step-on Guide Tour)

Travel through West Cape May to the tip of Cape May's peninsula, which is one of the most celebrated bird migratory locations in North America. As you enter Cape May Point State Park, you can view the fully-restored Cape May Lighthouse, built in 1859.

Include one or more of the following as part of your tour:

- Climb 199 steps to the top of the 1859 Cape May Lighthouse
- A guided walk to Cape May Point Beach. See the remains of the World War II bunker which was part of the Harbor Defense of the Delaware project of 1940.
- Visit the Nature Museum at Cape May Point State Park
- Walk along one of the park's Nature Trails
- Schedule "The Beacon" presentation in the park's classroom
- Visit the World War II Lookout Tower
- Visit Sunset Beach for a round of mini-golf or look for Cape May Diamonds

COMBINATION FISHERMAN'S WHARF/AQUACULTURE INNOVATION CENTER TROLLEY TOUR (OLDER STUDENTS ONLY)

Take a guided tour of the New Jersey Aquaculture Innovation Center (AIC) and learn about the Atlantic Surfclam Culture and Seed Oyster Production in New Jersey. Discover AIC's efforts to revitalize the oyster industry in the Delaware Bay and other East Coast bays and estuaries.

Following your visit, enjoy a guided tour of the Lobster House Dock and learn about the history of the harbor, the fishing industry and life at sea.

Include one or more of the following as part of your tour:

- Lunch at the Lobster House Restaurant
- Beachcombing with the Nature Center of Cape May
- Around Cape Island Boat Cruise
