Trees & lights will be available to decorate starting November 28th.
- All participants will receive a 4' x 4' foot area to decorate. If you wish to add Whimsical characters and/or miscellaneous props may be displayed in your 4' x 4' area to bring out fond memories of winter past.
- Please note electricity will not be fed into any display, lights must be solar powered.
- Displays must be constructed to withstand severe wind and rainy weather conditions. Use care in choosing your materials. All decorations must be firmly attached to your display. We recommend the use of staple guns, fishing line or string to secure items. Wet materials weigh the displays down!
- Displays must be in good taste. Those displays reflecting controversial, social, or political opinions or statements will NOT be accepted.
- Trees will be donated to the Cape May County Zoo for Animal enrichment after

the new year.
